This participatory clinic will consist of a presentation that includes performing a basic initial medical exam; including heart rate, respiratory rate, temperature, hydration status, gut sounds, and digital pulses. You will learn how vital signs change during common emergencies such as colic, lacerations, laminitis, or sole abscesses. You will learn about caring for your horse while waiting for the vet, such as using Banamine, and soaking or icing feet. Participants will learn how to take vital signs and wrap bandages.
